MONTHLY MINUTES
JUNE 13, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m.

The minutes from April 25, 2010 were reviewed. Pat made a motion to approve the minutes and Tim seconded. Minutes were unanimously approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Treasurer's Report: Lora reported the balance: \$24,641.22 (\$40,000 in C.D.)
-Aimee had a bill for \$118.19 to purchase Relay for Life leftovers.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Auction: No report

Promotions: No report

Golf Tournament: Tim reported that there are 3 teams already registered. He has ordered towels, coozies and t's. Golf Course rental is done, and tables and chairs have been reserved from Evans. Will advertise mid-July. They will need helpers.

Banner: Patrick reported that 2 out of 12 will not be renewing. It was decided that banners will not be moved to softball/baseball fields due to limited space. They will be re-hung at the track/football field in the fall.

Concessions: Aimee reported that Jenni is planning on continuing as chair; if she is unavailable, Angie Cummings will fill in. Also, the committee needs more openers.

Website: Tammie asked for more info please, regarding volunteers, banners, a thank you from the Auction Committee, pics and Tim said he will send her Golf Tournament history info.

Athletic Director: Scott reported a successful spring season for sports.
-Baseball concession is problem. Will look into possibly using old shed that was formerly a concession.
-Scott has assigned secretary to help with Central Office budget, keeping monthly tab on the situation. He reported being \$32,000 in the hole. His budget comes from gate receipts and activity passes. School Board says general fund not available for Athletic Department. Deanna made a motion to pay \$4585 of already approved bills, and Pat seconded. There will be a special meeting on 6/21 at 6 p.m. at Middle School to discuss the rest of the requested amounts. Booster Club requested that Jenny Artist be available with Purchase Orders and Invoices.
-Uniforms will have to be looked at in a case by case manner, in terms of replacement, due to the shortage of funds that the Athletic Department and Booster Club currently experiencing.

MS Athletic Director: Mark reported that they sold some banana track suits.
-Will need to order some new 7th Grade track uniforms in December, but all other sports appear to be set.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

New Business:

- Chelle will be sending out a Booster Club Auction Venue Questionnaire with 3 questions to the Booster Club Members and will put it on our Website.
- The Fiscal Year of the Booster Club is July 1 – June 30.
- The new freezer at concessions needs electrical upgrades more than originally thought – more to the tune of \$1000. We are going to see if someone would be willing to donate at least their labor to offset the cost.
- Storage Shed for Concessions. The old one is deteriorating and Booster Club has been thinking of building new one or adding on to the Concession stand. However, due to current financial situation, we will look at possibility of using part of the garage for storage.

Old Business:

- Speech Dept. requests we do food again for next years contests:
 - 1/22/11 – District Large Group
 - 3/12/11 – State Individual
- Cross Country dirt work has been done. Looking at having a place for spectators.
- Windscreens for Tennis Courts is on Scott's "To Do" list. He is looking at grants and getting someone to do an accurate measurement.
