The meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of February 13, 2011 were reviewed. Tim made note that the Golf Tournament date had changed from August 20, 2011 to August 27, 2011. Aimee made a motion to approve minutes as amended with correct Golf Tournament date. Motion was seconded by Angie. Minutes were unanimously approved as amended.

Coach Elam and Coach Kaufman, representing Baseball, attended the meeting. The coaches made a presentation regarding the need for a new set of white uniforms for the team. The need is for 20 tops and 25 pants, as the pants wear out quicker due to sliding. It was noted that Baseball is up for new uniforms, their last set being purchased in 2006. Tim made motion to purchase needed uniforms up to \$3000. This was seconded by Chris C. The motion was unanimously approved.

Tim made motion to approve payment of bills. Pat seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

AUCTION: Becky reported donations have been coming in. She has been trying to cut down on the cost of mailing by using email. Discussed what athletic teams could do to help with the auction. Knights of Columbus will be donating part of their proceeds back to the Booster Club.

PROMOTIONS: Angie reported beginning to prepare for spring sports. They are anticipating ordering more bag chairs to sell during the spring sport season.

GOLF TOURNAMENT: As noted in the Approval of Minutes, the Tournament has changed to August 20, 2011. Tim reported he needed to get \$1000 check to the Golf Course for rental for that day.

BANNERS: Patrick reported that of the 29 banners up for renewal this year, 16 have paid. He will begin hanging banners this week, but away from where the scoreboard is going up.

CONCESSIONS: Jennie & Aimee reported that we will probably need to raise prices on a few items to keep up with increasing grocery prices. Jennie reported that the Booster Club is on the list to have a table at RAGBRAI this summer. The table rental will be around \$500.

WEBSITE: No report.

SPEECH CONTEST CAFÉ: Chelle reported the speech café went well, estimated to have made \$2500 - \$3000.

HIGH SCHOOL AD: Scott submitted bills for Senior Night flowers for Girls & Boys Basketball and Dance Team, Daktronics for football/track scoreboard & baseball and soccer scoreboard additions. Discussion ensued regarding the breakdown of expenses for the scoreboard project. Discussed polo shirts & pullovers for the golf teams, Lora made a motion to purchase 18 polo shirts & pullovers for girls and 18 polo shirts & pullovers for boys with Booster Club funding 100%, up to a \$3000 limit. Jennie seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved. Discussed purchasing windscreens for the tennis court, as well as adding a logo. Tim made a motion to purchase tennis windscreens with a 42" "G" logo. Angie seconded this motion, which was unanimously approved. Discussion ensued regarding the need for a new softball batting cage. Decision made to patch the cage for one more year of use, so a new cage can be purchased next year to stay in line with plans to improve entire complex.

MIDDLE SCHOOL AD: No report.

PRESIDENTS REPORT: Ram Family Fundraiser – Bill will talk with Stan Winquist about having a student make a pedestal for the statues. Bill & Chelle presented the Chamber of Commerce Club of the Year Award to the group. The plaque will be placed somewhere in the school trophy case.

NEW BUSINESS

RAGBRAI – Jennie is looking into what training we may need to have to serve food. The availability of the school kitchen was discussed, many groups are desiring this facility. Discussion ensued regarding having a committee for RAGBRAI fundraising.
